To be considered for the scholarship(s) please:

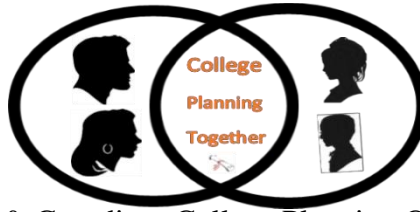
- Complete and submit the scholarship application
